The Int. Association for Wind Engineering (IAWE, <u>www.iawe.org</u>) is glad to announce its cooperation with CISM (International Centre for Mechanical Sciences) by supporting the above **Advanced School (AS)** through the award of six (6) grants covering entirely the Early Bird On-site participation registration fee¹.

The IAWE grants will be awarded to young active researchers (graduate, post-graduate or post-doctoral) in the field of wind energy/engineering in the three Regions of IAWE (i.e. 2 grants per Region: North/South America, Europe/Africa, Asia/Oceania). The Region of belonging of the awardees will be determined by the country of achievement of the 1st University degree, i.e. Bachelor's degree or equivalent. Max eligible age: 35 years (at Sept. 15, 2025), with max 8 years after award of the PhD degree (undergraduate students will not be admitted/eligible).

The Candidates/Applicants shall submit via E-mail to the Secretariat of IAWE (Dr. Cornelia Kalender, secr.general@iawe.org) within May 20th, 2005.225, 12:00 CET the following documents:

(i) informal application letter (with all personal data including home country - i.e. country of current registered residence – date and place of birth), (ii) short CV (max 2 pages), (iii) current affiliation (if any), (iv) current operating E-mail address.

At the same time, the Candidates shall register for the Advanced School and could apply for a CISM grant (s. below), however in any case the Awardees of a IAWE grant will not be eligible to receive also the CISM grant.

The Selection Committee will be appointed by the Exec. Board of IAWE and will be formed by the Coordinators and three IAWE officers (representing the 3 IAWE Regions). Notification will be sent to Awardees within June 30th, 2025.

The final confirmation of the Advanced School will be published within Sept. 2nd, 2025 at the very latest, but actually it could occur even earlier (depending on the actual number of registered attendees). All registered participants and teachers will be notified in due time.

CISM GRANTS

A limited number of participants from universities and research centres who do not receive support from their institutions can request a waiver of the registration fee and/or free lodging.
